Candidate for SCACC Vice-President

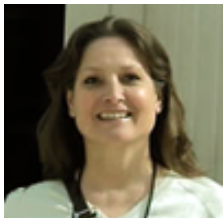
Woody Parks

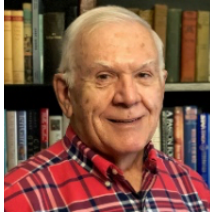
Candidate for SCACC Secretary

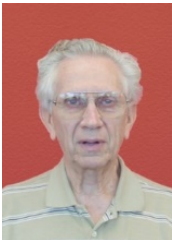
Philip Livingston
